A Scholarship account has been established in Ray's name at KHS and in 2018 five \$500 scholarships were awarded to:



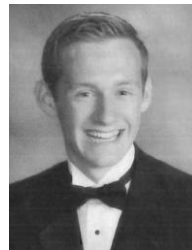
