**The deadline for submissions is April 15, 2020.** The winner will be selected in May and will be announced at his/her high school sports/awards ceremony.

The award will be presented upon successful entrance into a college or university or trade school. The Board reserves the right to withhold the scholarship award from any individual who does not enter college or trade school the year of winning or submit valid proof of enrollment by October 1<sup>st</sup> 2020.
